Applying Organic SilageKing at harvest improves silage preservation through activating the beneficial ensiling bacteria present on the forage, and by inhibiting the microbes responsible for silage decomposition and spoilage. Organic SilageKing can be used for pasture, cereal, lucerne or maize silage preservation.

Application Rate: Pasture, cereal, lucerne and maize silage apply 150 mL/wet tonne.

Directions for use: Apply Organic SilageKing at harvest through a suitable applicator. Prior to use clean the applicator system to remove any product residues. To maximise the efficacy of Organic SilageKing it should always be used in conjunction with good silage making practices see www.biostart. co.nz/silageking. Factors such as moisture content of the forage, compaction and sealing of the stack or bales, and contamination of silage by either soil, fertiliser and/or effluent, may impact on the efficacy of Organic SilageKing and the feed quality of the resulting silage.
