BioStart Terracin contains a naturally occurring strain of Bacillus amyloliquefaciens BS 1b. Terracin can be used to suppress Armillaria in kiwifruit. It works by colonizing the rhizosphere and providing a level of protection against the Armillaria fungi.

Application: For best results apply to damp soil or water in. Sprayers should be calibrated before use. Do not apply onto or into waterways.

Compatibility: Apply Terracin on its own. Do not mix Terracin with BioStart Mycorrcin or BioStart Digester.

Resistance management: Terracin contains Bacillus amyloliquefaciens strain Bs1b and is part of the FRAC BM 02 fungicide group that consists of Biologicals with multiple modes of action (MOA), in the Biological Group of Bacterial Bacillus species. The BM 02 category was established by FRAC to accommodate a wide range of microbes with multiple modes of action that are not known to produce resistance issues and have a low risk of producing resistance. Terracin will assist in managing fungicide resistance provided it is used strictly in accordance with the label instructions and the resistance management strategies that exist for any fungus listed on the label.
